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The SUNY New Paltz School of Business announces the return of the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program, which provides free tax help to individuals with a gross income of \$64,000 or less.

The VITA program connects community members with certified student volunteers who have received IRS training to provide basic tax return preparation assistance and free e-filing.

Starting on Monday February 5 and until April 15, 2024, taxpayers may have their 2023 returns prepared either virtually or in person.

If you are interested in taking advantage of this free service, please be sure you have the following available for upload:

- ☑ Passport and visa
- ☑ Tax forms issued by employers and/or bank (ex. W-2, 1099). If you don't have your W-2, you must get it from your employer.
- ☑ Complete Form 13614 NR
- ☑ Actual SSN Card or the ITIN letter
- ☑ Form 1095-B, Health Coverage Statement
- ☑ Last year's tax return (if available)
- ☑ Bank routing and account numbers for direct deposit
