maintain your visa status at SUNY New Paltz, you must register full time, attend, and actively participate in your classes!

Full-time enrollment and Academic engagement requirements

"Full-time" enrollment may differ depending on your program ALL Undergraduate degrees, MBA, and MFA: 12 credits ALL other graduate degrees: 9 credits A combination of ESL and academic courses are OK! If you withdraw from a class and doing so drops you below full-time at any point

All international students present in the United States or continuing their studies from

outside the U.S. in Active SEVIS status must maintain full-time enrollment*. To

Failure to do so will result in deregistration, which will jeopardize your visa status.

you will be in violation of your visa status. Do not do this. An exception is made in your FINAL SEMESTER only.

to enroll full-time until they have entered the country on F-1 status.

Academic engagement required to maintain your status

*New students who have not yet entered the United States on F-1 status do not need

your visa status. According to the Registrar:

- have ever attended and participated in their course based on your academic engagement. If they report that you have never attended or participated in their course, you will be automatically withdrawn from the class, and this will jeopardize

Academic engagement is the active participation by the student in an instructional

On February 22, your faculty are required to report to the Registrar whether you

physically or online, where there is an opportunity for interaction between the instructor and students; Submitting an academic assignment;

Attending a synchronous class, lecture, recitation, or field or laboratory activity,

Participating in a study group, group project, or an online discussion that is assigned by the institution; or

assisted instruction;
