▶ All air travelers entering the US from abroad will also need show results of a negative

Travel signatures are valid for 6 months and are required for re-entry into the US

F-1 travel signatures must be requested through the link.

vaccines If you are completing your program this semester, (and you are not applying for OPT),

you do not need a travel signature and you have a 60-day grace period in the US when

COVID test taken within 24 hours of their flight's departure from a foreign country

Note for J-1 students: If you are completing your program this semester, you do not need a Travel Signature, and you have a 30-day grace period in the US when your program ends.


