Late Registration/Course Drop Deadline Approaching (September 11)

As a reminder, all F-1 and J-1 students must be enrolled full-time unless it is your last semester and you received a Reduced Courseload Authorization.

Per the [Academic Calendar](#), Late Course Registration/Course Drop is September 5 - 11 and "Course Add requires electronic permission from the instructor and \$20 course change fee."

REMINDER: Act Now: Confirm your enrollment

If you have not already done so: It is time to confirm your enrollment. Pay at least 50% of your tuition or accept the time payment plan. Then you will be able to confirm your enrollment. Go to [my.newpaltz.edu](#) and **click on the pop-up message to confirm enrollment**. Once your enrollment is confirmed, you will be able to see your Brightspace course site. [More information?](#)

If you registered this week, you will need to accept your financial responsibility and pay at least 50% of your bill or accept a time payment plan in order to access the Confirmation of Enrollment within 24 hours.

If you have not yet registered and do not have a student bill, you must complete this process as soon as you are registered and billed by Student Accounts.
