• ALL Undergraduate degrees, MBA, and MFA: 12 credits • ALL other graduate degrees: 9 credits

 A combination of ESL and academic courses are OK! If you withdraw from a class and doing so drops you below full time at any point

you will be in violation of your visa status. Do not do this. An exception is made in your FINAL SEMESTER only


