## Full-time enrollment requirements

All international students must maintain full-time status. "Full-time" may differ depending on your program

 ALL Undergraduate degrees, MBA, and MFA: 12 credits ALL other graduate degrees: 9 credits

- **Method of instruction** 
  - Only ONE online course counts toward the full-time registration requirement Most of your courses must be seated and/or hybrid each semester.

• In your final semester, if you are only taking one course, it cannot be an online


