As we approach course registration for Fall 2023, please remember international students have (F1) status requirements that relate to your academics!

"Full-time" may differ depending on your program

All international students must maintain full-time status.

Full-time enrollment requirements

 ALL Undergraduate degrees, MBA, and MFA: 12 credits • ALL other graduate degrees: 9 credits An exception to Full-time enrollment is made in your FINAL SEMESTER only

- Only ONE online course counts toward the full-time registration requirement each semester. Most of your courses must be seated and/or hybrid each semester.
- Practicum, Internship, Fieldwork courses, and CPT approval
- type of off-campus opportunity. For example, if you are registering for Practicum, Internship, Fieldwork, or an Independent Study that has an off-campus component, you must get CPT authorization before you begin your internship/practicum/fieldwork.
