

Therefore, we recommend you review the following sites for information. • SUNY Vaccine Policy The student vaccination requirement went into effect on Aug. 23, 2021 Following the FDA approval of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine on Aug. 23, 2021, all SUNY students are now required to show proof of full vaccination. Unvaccinated students have a 35-day grace period to get fully vaccinated; the

Those who do not comply will be withdrawn from in-person classes at SUNY

Any of the three vaccines currently available in the U.S. (Johnson & Johnson, Pfizer or Moderna) will meet this requirement. (Vaccines approved by the World
