



SUNY INTERNATIONAL INBOUND STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE

The Student Health Insurance Plan Offers You:

- Unlimited coverage for primary care providers, specialists, emergency visits and hospitals
- Unlimited coverage for preventative care, including annual physicals, GYN exams, routine screenings and immunizations
- Prescription Drug Coverage: \$10 copay for tier 1 drugs, and a \$20 copay for tier 2 or 3 drugs
- Unlimited coverage for inter-collegiate athletics
- Unlimited coverage for mental health
- Evacuation and Repatriation Services
- Teledoc service for minor sickness, injury & mental health

Who is eligible:

All international students and visiting scholars (J1 & F1 visa holders) are eligible and must be enrolled in the plan, unless a waiver is granted by SUNY. Students participating in Optional Practical Training programs and visiting scholars in other visa categories are also eligible and may be required to enroll by their host SUNY campus. Eligible students may also insure their Dependents. Eligible Dependents are the student's spouse or domestic partner and dependent children under 26 years of age.

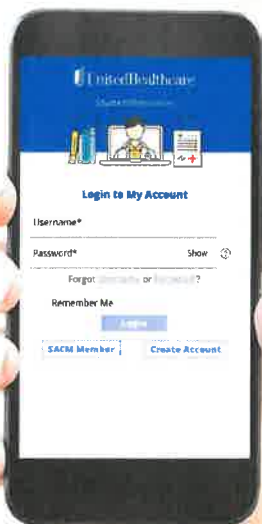

Easy Access with UHCSR's Mobile App



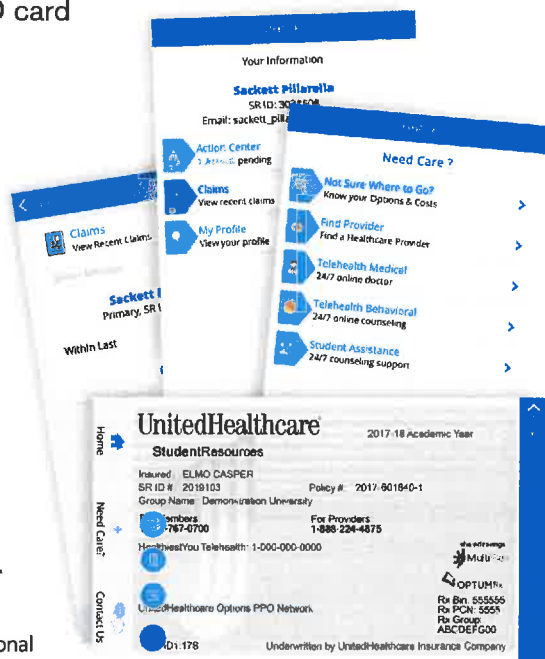

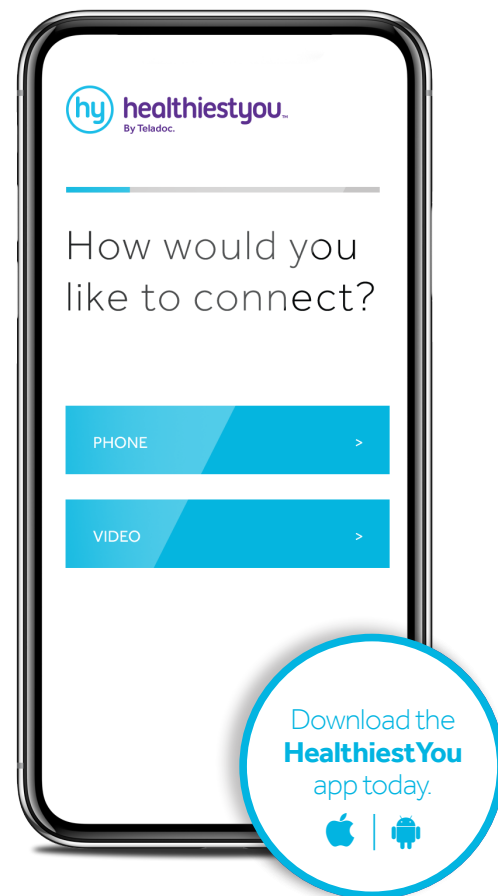
